I know that Christians show their beliefs through actions such as prayer.

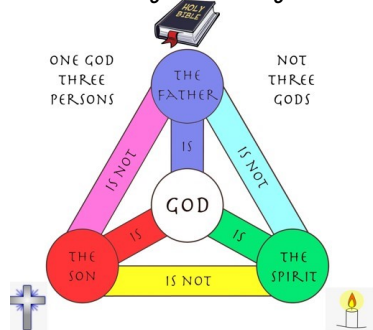
Key information

Creed	A formal statement of Christian beliefs.
Trinity	The three persons to the Christian Godhead, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
Sins	When a person goes against the religion it is known as a sin.
Ten commandments	Important rules that Christians believe God has created on how to live.
Sacrifice	An act of surrendering a person or animal as an offering to God for forgiveness.
Holy spirit	The third person in the trinity, being God as spiritually active in the world.
Second coming	The prophesied return of Christ to Earth.
