





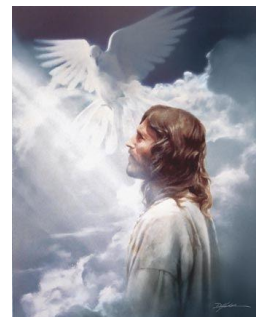
Religious Education: Inspirational people from the past (3.4)

Religions to be explored:

 <p>Abrahamic Religions</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Abrahamic religions are Christianity, Judaism and Islam. • They make up over half of the world's population. • They all come from a man called Abraham who started the chain of events to these religions forming, Abraham being known as the patriarch.
 <p>Moses</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Moses is an inspirational person from the past, known as a law-giver to Jews. • He protected the people around. • The day he received the 10 commandments is celebrated through Passover known as Pesach.
 <p>Prophet Muhammed</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Muhammed was known as a Prophet when he was chosen by God. • It is believed he was chosen because he was wise and fair and concerned for all. • Ramadan remembers when Prophet Muhammad received the Quran
 <p>Jesus</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Jesus is known as the messiah in Christianity. • Christians believe that Jesus was God in a human body who worked out miracles as a sign of his relationship to God.



Key Vocabulary

Religion	The belief and worship of a God or Gods in a system of belief and worship
Christian	A Christian is someone who believes in and follows the teachings of Jesus Christ
Muslim	Believing in and practising Islam
Jewish	Believing in and practising Judaism.
Prophet	A person sent by God to teach the people and give them messages from God.
Messiah	A leader who is believed to have been chosen to save humanity.
Patriarch	A male leader known as father of the human race in religion.
Miracles	An unusual and mysterious event that is thought to have been caused by a god because it does not follow the usual laws of nature
Exodus	The movement of a lot of people from a place.
Inspiration	When somebody inspires somebody to do something.
