## Geographical Concepts

<b>distribution</b>	The pattern of where physical and human features are located.
<b>economic activity</b>	Making a product or providing something that others pay for.
<b>environment</b>	The particular physical and human characteristics which make a place distinctive.
<b>location</b>	The position of something.
<b>rural</b>	Areas of countryside outside towns and cities.
<b>settlement</b>	Any place where people live such as a village or city
<b>trade</b>	Buying and selling goods and services between people and countries.
<b>urban</b>	A built up area with a high population

## Key Vocabulary

<b>Botanical Garden</b>	A place containing many different plants.
<b>city</b>	A place where many people live and work closely together alongside shops, offices and businesses.
<b>congestion</b>	Very full or crowded with people.
<b>employment</b>	The occupation or work by which
<b>heritage</b>	A valued history.
<b>industrial</b>	Businesses that provide products or services.
<b>leisure</b>	Time away from work or other duties that take time and effort.
<b>National Park</b>	A protected area of countryside.
<b>pollution</b>	Something added to the environment which is harmful to living things.
<b>population</b>	The total number of people living in a city, country or other area.
<b>retail</b>	To sell products to people.
