


The Seven Continents and Five Oceans of the World

Continent	A continent is a very large area of land that consists of many countries.	The 7 continents are Europe Asia North America South America Africa Australia (also known as Australasia and Oceania) Antarctica
Ocean	An ocean is a very large area of salt water on the Earth's surface.	The 5 oceans are Pacific Ocean Atlantic Ocean Arctic Ocean Indian Ocean Southern Ocean
compass point	Any of the four points of a compass: north, south, east or west	
country	An area of land controlled by its own government	
island	A piece of land completely surrounded by water	
sea	A large area of salty water which is part of an ocean	
village	A small group of houses, perhaps with a few shops, that are often in the countryside.

The Pacific Ocean is the largest ocean.

The Arctic Ocean is the smallest ocean.
