 Christianity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Christianity is the worlds biggest religion. • It is based on the teachings of Jesus Christ. • Christians go to Church to worship. • The cross is the symbol for Christianity.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A christening is for a baby. • For a baby to be christened it has to be decided by their parents. • Christenings involve pouring holy water over the babies head.
 Believers Baptism	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A believers baptism is for a young adult who has decided themselves to believe in God. • They have to have their whole body submerged into the holy water during baptism.
