



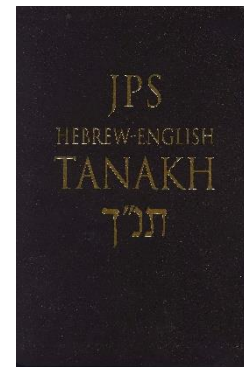
# Religious Education: Jewish and Christian Stories (2.4)

## The Agreed Syllabus for RE in Nottinghamshire Syllabus:

- Gather information of characters who 'got it wrong' and observe what happened.

 <p>Christianity</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Christianity is the worlds biggest religion.</li> <li>• Christians follow the Bible, believing in God.</li> <li>• The Bible is full of religious stories to guide and teach followers of Christianity.</li> <li>• A person who follows Christianity is called a Christian.</li> <li>• Christians go to a Church to worship.</li> </ul>
 <p>Judaism</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A person who follows Judaism is called a Jew.</li> <li>• Jews follow the Torah, believing in God.</li> <li>• The Torah has 5 religious stories to guide and teach followers of Judaism.</li> <li>• Jews go to a Synagogue to worship.</li> </ul>

Torah	The first five books of the Jewish Bible that Jews read in a Synagogue.
Christian	 Someone who believes in and follows the teachings of Jesus.
Jew	Someone whose traditional religion is Judaism.
Forgiving	Allows you to make mistakes and forgives you for them. 
Courage	Being able to control your fear in situations.
Persistence	Keep going at something and doing it again and again.
Jewish Bible	A Holy book of Jewish religion known as the Tanakh.
God	The being who made the universe and is believed to have an effect on all things.
