Key information

- Meden Vale used to be called Welbeck Colliery Village.
- It became Meden Vale in 1975, named after the River Meden.
- Some of the houses were built for miners to live in.
- Miners went underground into a mine to dig for coal.
- Coal was burned on fires for heat and used to make electricity.
- The mine was open for nearly 100 years.
- After the mine was demolished Welbeck Colliery Solar Farm was built on the pit hillside.

Key Vocabulary

coal	A hard black rock that is found in the earth and burned on fires.
colliery	A coal mine.
headstocks	Tall frames used for pulling up coal, out of the ground.
mine	A deep hole or area of holes made in in the earth to dig out coal.
miner	Someone who works in a mine.
pit	A coal mine
Pit tub	Small trucks pushed and pulled from the mine carrying coal.
