### Previous learning

#### I'm learning French:

### **Grammar we will learn & revisit:**

Nouns, articles/determiners & possessive adjectives. Exploring possessive adjectives in French with a focus only on 'my'. Understanding that there are three words in French mon, ma and mes for our one word 'my' in English. Moving from 'I am' and 'I have' to 'he/she is' and 'he/she has'.
