Prior learning

I'm learning French:

- I know 'hello' and 'goodbye' in French.

Grammar we will learn & revisit:

Nouns, definite articles/determiners and high frequency verb 'jouer' in 1st person singular only.

Using a noun (instrument) with the correct definite article and 1st person singular form of the verb 'jouer' (to play), 'je joue' (I play).

Learning that nouns in French can have different articles based on their gender (masculine/ feminine nouns) and plurality.

Introduction to three definite articles le, la and les (l' is not seen in this unit).

Learning how to categorise nouns in French by their article/determiner, gender and plurality.
