- Safe - making choices that keep ourselves and others safe in classrooms, corridors, playgrounds, and beyond.

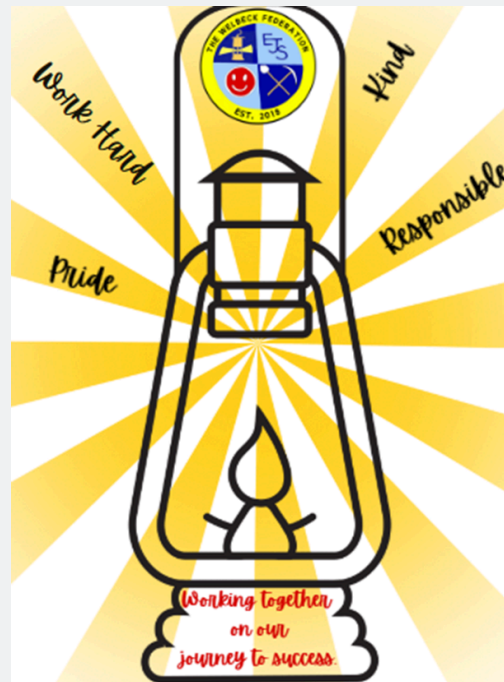

Assessing Learning

We review your child's development every term using observations and assessments based on the EYFS framework. These include:

Ongoing Observations (Formative Assessment)

- Teachers watch how your child plays, explores, and learns during daily activities. We note their interests, skills, and next steps. This helps us understand what they know and what they need to learn next.

Termly Summaries (Summative Assessment)

- At the end of each term, we bring together all observations and evidence to give a clear picture of your child's progress across the seven areas of learning. This shows how they are developing and where extra support or challenge might help.

What you will receive...

You'll receive an overview of how your child is developing across the EYFS prime and specific areas of learning.

This includes:

- Communication and Language
- Personal, Social and Emotional Development
- Physical Development
- Literacy (early reading and writing skills)
- Mathematics (early number and shape understanding)
- Understanding the World
- Expressive Arts and Design



We use these terms to describe progress:

Working Towards

Your child is developing skills but needs more support.

On Track

Your child is on track for their age-related expectations.

Attendance

Even though attendance isn't statutory until your child turns 5, every day still counts. Being in Nursery or Reception regularly helps your child learn, make friends, and feel happy and confident. Each day is full of fun activities that build skills and prepare them for school.

Our school target is 97% attendance.

Tracking attendance helps us:

- Spot patterns early and offer support if needed.
- Ensure your child doesn't miss key lessons and experiences.
- Work together with families to keep learning on track.
